



## **Game Plan: College Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Q: What are office hours and workshops?**

A: During office hours, you can come in and get one-on-one advising with a Teen Advisor. We'll answer questions about where you are on your path to college and help you figure out what your next steps are. During workshops, Teen Advisors present information to a group on a variety of topics. We have a workshop calendar, and you can come to the ones that work for your schedule and your needs.

### **Q: How do I get started?**

A: Our Jumpstart Workshop is designed to do give you an overview of what we do and how we do it, and is the perfect place to start. ***Jumpstart Workshops are offered Mondays and Wednesdays from 5-6 PM.*** All high-schoolers (9th-12th grade) are welcome to attend.

### **Q: Can you help me with my essay, resume, and applications?**

A: Yes, we can help you with essays, resumes, and applications! Come in with whatever you have (or nothing at all!), and we will help you get to where you want to be.

### **Q: Do I have to pay to participate in this program?**

A: No, *Game Plan: College* is FREE!

### **Q: Do you have staff who speak in Spanish?**

A: Yes, we have staff who speak Spanish working every day.

### **Q: Are undocumented students eligible to attend?**

A: Yes! We provide undocumented students with the same services that we provide all students.

### **Q: Do you offer tutoring or scholarships?**

A: No, we do not assist with homework or offer scholarships. However, we are happy to help you think about course selection and find scholarship opportunities.

### **Q: If I am a part of the *Game Plan: College* program, does that mean that I'm a part of *Scholars to College* program?**

A: No, *Game Plan: College* and *Scholars to College* are two separate programs, with separate services and separate staff.
