

Game Plan: College Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are office hours and workshops?

A: During office hours, you can come in and get one-on-one advising with a Teen Advisor. We'll answer questions about where you are on your path to college and help you figure out your next steps. During workshops, Teen Advisors present information to a group on a variety of topics. We have a workshop calendar, and you can come to the ones that work for your schedule and your needs.

Q: How do I get started?

A: Our Jumpstart Workshop is designed to do give you an overview of what we do and how we do it, and is the perfect place to start. **Jumpstart Workshops are offered Mondays from 5-6 PM.** All high-schoolers (9th-12th grade) are welcome to attend.

Q: Can you help me with my college list, applications and essays?

A: Yes, we can help you with all of the above. Come in with whatever you have (or nothing at all!), and we will help you get to where you want to be.

Q: Do I have to pay to participate in this program?

A: No, *Game Plan: College* is FREE!

Q: Do you have staff who speak in Spanish?

A: Yes, we have staff who speak Spanish working every day.

Q: Are undocumented students eligible to attend?

A: Yes! We provide undocumented students with the same services that we provide all students.

Q: Do you offer tutoring or scholarships?

A: No, we do not assist with homework or offer scholarships. However, we are happy to help you think about course selection and find scholarship opportunities.

Q: If I am a part of the *Game Plan: College* program, does that mean that I'm a part of *Scholars to College* program?

A: No, *Game Plan: College* and *Scholars to College* are two separate programs, with separate services and separate staff.
